Why Community Pharmacy?

Pharmacists and the pharmacy team can be seen without an appointment. They are experts in healthcare and able to deal with the minor symptoms that you may suffer with, both during and following treatments involving chemotherapy and radiotherapy.

Most have a quiet are where you can speak more privately and many are open in the evenings and at weekends

Most pharmacies are easily accessible with convenient parking nearby.

This service is free to all patients registered with a Sheffield GP.

How can the pharmacy help?

The pharmacist can help you with the following symptoms which, although minor are unpleasant and can cause complications if not treated.

- Constipation
- Dry Mouth
- Dry Skin
- Eye Irritation
- Skin Inflammation
- Sore Mouth

Important Note (If you are still undergoing treatment)

If you suffer any of the following symptoms the pharmacist will direct you to Weston Park Hospital

- Temperatures of 37.5° or more
- Symptoms of infection
- Feeling generally unwell
- Bleeding or bruising
- Nausea and vomiting
- Diarrhoea
- Chest pains
- Breathlessness
- Changes affecting sensations

Self-care

Taking care of your general health by looking after your heart, bones and lungs may help reduce the risk of certain late effects. You can do this by:

- taking regular physical activity
- keeping to a healthy weight and eating healthily
- not smoking
- avoid alcohol
