How do I find the contact details for my community pharmacy?

Contact details for your community pharmacy are usually on the label on your medicines.

How long does it take to get my medicines?

After requesting your medicines from your doctor's surgery, please allow 7 days for your surgery to issue your prescription and your pharmacy to get your medicines ready for you. If your medicines are urgent, it can still take a few hours for the prescription to be sent to your pharmacy electronically.
